Within the context of the recent Italian Government document published in the Official State Gazzette (n.126, 3 June 2014) on the use of and consent for cookies, this document aims to provide detailed explanation of the use of so-called "cookies", as well as other such similar technologies (such as web beacons/web bugs, clear GIFs, pixel tags etc) on the computers of users who visit our website (PCs, tablets, smartphones etc). Cookies allow us to improve the sectors that we offer; some are essential for our website to function correctly, while others help improve the service and experience it offers our users. Below, you can find detailed information on cookies, which type of cookies are used on our website, how to disable them via your browser and how to block the so-called "third-party" cookies.

What are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are saved onto users' computers (or other devices used to visit our Website, as mentioned above). For more general information, please visit http://www.allaboutcookies.org/

What type of cookies do we use?

Session cookies	Persistent cookies
these identify the user during visits to our Website, and allow them to interact with it. Once the user closes the session - i.e. the browser is closed - they are deleted from the system. They are temporary in nature.	these are saved onto users' hard drives (or other devices), and remain there until the user chooses to delete them, or they reach their pre-set expiry-date. As such, the time they remain on the hard drive depends on the type of cookie and users' browser settings.

Cookies can be further divided into **technical cookies**, **profiling cookies** and **third-party cookies**. Technical cookies used by the Website, in that they are the cookies that allow the site to function properly, fall
